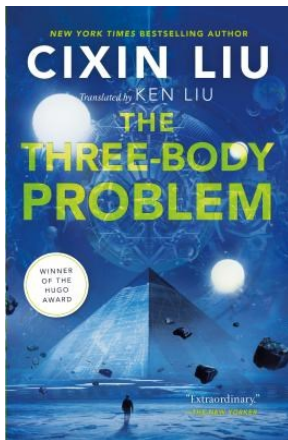


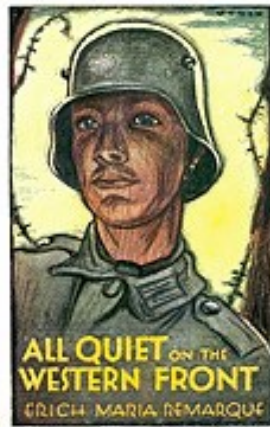
# A Book That Was Translated from a Different Language

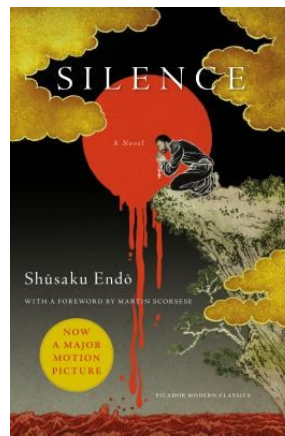

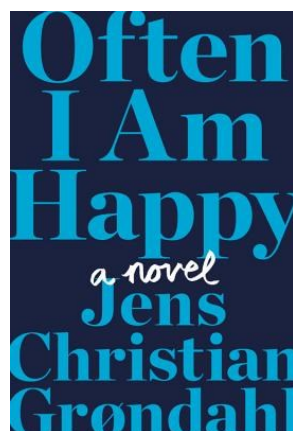

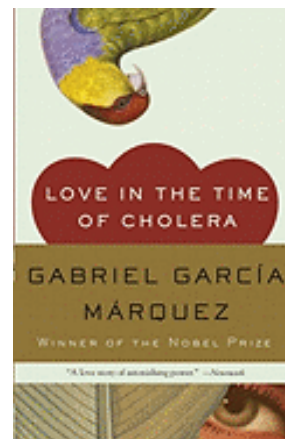
