Children birth to 11

Drawing tickets are earned every 10 days and can be entered to win one of 6 teen prizes.

Adults over 19 can earn up to 3 prize drawing tickets for a chance to win one of 6 adult prizes. Tickets are earned for every 10 days of reading.

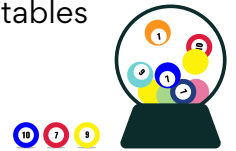

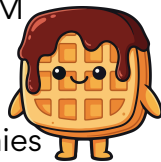

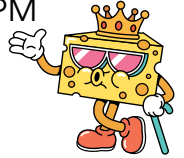
